IN THE EVENT OF FIRE OR SMOKE, OCCUPANTS WILL: LEAVE the fire area, taking any persons in the immediate vicinity

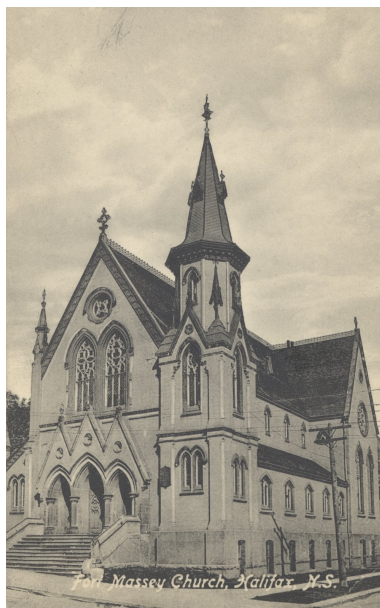

Exit **IMMEDIATELY – Do not use the elevators!** Assist other occupants as necessary. **GO** to a safe area. Call 911. **DO NOT RE-ENTER** the building until the Chief Fire Official declares it is **SAFE** to do so. Go to a grouping area outside the building. Follow the directions of the Fire Department.
